Position Summary: Responsible for the provision of direct hospice care and support to patients & families and, on each assigned tour of duty, ensuring that the overall standards of nursing practice and patient care are met and within the policies and objectives of Hospice Calgary and C.A.R.N.A.

Role Includes:

- Providing nursing care to individuals during their last days and weeks of life and support to family members and friends.
- Ongoing patient assessment and evaluation of needs including physical, psycho-social and spiritual needs.
- Participating in patient care review rounds with multi-disciplinary team members.
- Supervising duties of Patient Care Attendant.
- Consulting and collaborating with other health care professionals within the Hospice Calgary team.
- Assisting with development and implementation of a plan of care in cooperation with the patient, family and Hospice Calgary team.
- Maintaining accurate documentation of care to patient and response by patient and family to that care.
- Providing information on available community resources to families.

Requirements:

- Current C.A.R.N.A. registration.
- Mature individual; excellent written and verbal communication skills; flexible style.
- Experience in hospice and/or palliative care an asset.
- Strong team member.
- Ability to work independently, with minimal supervision.
- Ability to handle competing demands with confidence and promptness.
- Willingness to participate in continuous learning and growth opportunities.

Rosedale Hospice is our community-based residential hospice, which provides 24-hour end-of-life care for individuals with cancer and support for their families and friends.
