

**GOOD GRIEF LEVEL II**  
**Assessment, Interventions and Disenfranchised Grief**

**DESCRIPTION**

This one day workshop will focus on the assessment and creative interventions useful when supporting grieving children and teens. Their families may have someone with a life-threatening illness or they may be grieving the death of a family member or close friend.

Disenfranchised grief (unrecognized grief) may be experienced by those who are survivors of suicide or families preparing for end-of-life. In order to meet their unique needs, specialized knowledge in these areas is required. This workshop will develop skills and provide strategies for assisting families experiencing the isolation of disenfranchised grief.
